Kimberley Reflections is the culmination of Tura’s Reflection2 Tour across the Kimberley, bringing together Indigenous icons Mark Atkins and Stephen Pigram with some of Australia’s finest instrumentalists and guest artists. This unique and powerful combination of artists will present a program that reaches across cultures, time and place.

Three of the artists who will be collaborating with the Tour in the Kimberley will be coming to Perth for this unique Tour finale: Gabriel Nodea (Warmun), Danny Marr (Fitzroy Crossing) and Ashley Oobagooma (Derby).

The program features a rich tapestry of songs by Stephen Pigram, Mark Atkins and the Kimberley artists along with Atkin’s virtuosic didgeridoo. Reflections also premieres new compositions inspired by the extraordinary locations artists have travelled to on the Tour.

The program will feature powerful imagery recorded on Tour through the Kimberley.

A Yarnitji man, of Irish heritage, Mark is also a storyteller, composer, percussionist, visual artist and instrument maker.

Hailing from Broome in Australia’s far North West Kimberley region, Stephen Pigram is a singer/songwriter and multi-instrumentalist musician playing acoustic guitar, harmonica, ukulele and more. He is one seventh of the Pigram Brothers band whose particular kind of ‘saltwater country’ music has attracted many fans both in Australia and beyond.




DANNY MARR
